

Bluefield College is a highly regarded liberal arts college that is located in southwest Virginia near the West Virginia border. It is in the top tier of Southern Colleges and Michael will pursue his bachelor's degree in wildlife conservation and environmental studies. Bluefield College is a charter member of the **Division II**, **Appalachian Athletic Conference and competes in the N.A.I.A.**

In his own right, Michael has clearly established himself as an exceptional athlete having been selected as an "All Conference" varsity soccer player for the last 2 years. Michael is also highly ranked in the state's top 10 list for offense among all high school varsity soccer players and his statistical record speaks for itself. During the 2015-16 season Michael averaged 1.2 goals per game with a "points per game" average of 2.9. Over the last two varsity season's Michael played in 33 games, has scored 30 goals, contributed 11 assists and has led his Team's offense with a total of 71 points.
